LETTER OF INTENT

Sir / Madam,

Sub: Issuance of Letter of Intent for establishment of new Degree Engineering & Technology institution in the name and style of CMR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, KANDLAKOYA (V), MEDCHAL, HYDERABABD, ANDHRA PRADESH - 501 401 for the block period 2005-08.

This is with reference to your application submitted to the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for establishment of new technical institution for the academic year 2005-06.

I am directed to convey the decision of the Council to issue the letter of Intent (LOI) for establishment of new Degree Engineering & Technology institution in the name and style of CMR INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, KANDLAKOYA (V), MEDCHAL, HYDERABABD, ANDHRA PRADESH - 501 401 based on the recommendations of the Hearing Committee and EC Sub-Committee, which examined your proposal as per the procedures, guidelines, policy and norms & standards of AICTE. The Letter of Intent will be valid for three academic years.

To facilitate further processing of the proposal for grant of approval, you are now requested to furnish the following documents in one lot to the concerned Regional Office of AICTE, on or before February 28, 2005.

1. A registered undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper of not less than Rs. 100/-, stating that the Institution shall abide by all the Regulations, Guidelines, Norms and Standards of the Council as applicable from time to time.
2. As per the new policy a 'Refundable Performance Guarantee Fee (RPGF)' in the form of a Demand Draft in favour of "The Member Secretary, AICTE", on any nationalized bank payable at New Delhi for an amount as applicable to the category of the institutions indicated below:

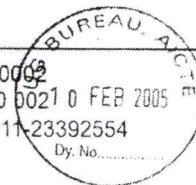

This RPGF will be deposited in AICTE A/C at the Head Quarters, in the form of a Fixed Deposit for a period of at least 8 years. The interest accrued shall be remitted to the Institution on yearly basis strictly for the purpose of giving Scholarships and Books to meritorious but needy students. On successful completion of 8 years of existence, the Performance Guarantee Deposit will be released for the purpose of the development of the institution. However, the period of fixed deposit may be extended beyond the initial period of 8 years in case of failure to comply with the norms and standards / complaints against the institution.

3. Original documents related to the land for the proposed institution and the other existing institutions (if any) for verification.

4. The site plan for the proposed land in relation to the adjoining built up structures, road etc.
5. The building plan for the proposed institution clearly mentioning the survey numbers of the land area.
6. A non-refundable visiting fee of Rs. 50,000/- drawn in favour of The Member Secretary, AICTE on any nationalized bank payable at New Delhi.

If any of the above requirements is not fulfilled, your proposal shall not be eligible for further processing and is liable to be rejected for the academic year 2005-06 and shall stand transferred for the academic year 2006-2007.

Subject to the fulfillment of all the conditions mentioned above by the cut-off date, and upon receipt of confirmation of preparedness of applicant Trust / Society for Expert Committee visit latest by **March 31, 2005**, an Expert Committee visit shall be arranged by the Council for verification of all the facilities required for establishment of a new institution.

The Visiting Expert Committee will verify that all the necessary infrastructure facilities have been created for the proposed institution, as indicated below, as per Norms of AICTE.

1. The land of the proposed Institution has been fully developed with clear demarcations, either by a boundary wall / barbed wire fencing and all weather approach road to the Institution.
2. Clear cut demarcation of the built up space for the proposed institution from the built up space for the existing institution/s (if any in the same land/premises).
3. Building is complete in all respects including plastering, internal electrification and effective conduct of classes etc. at least adequate for first year of the programme.
4. Permanent electrical and potable water connection is obtained.
5. All the required furniture and fixtures are in place as per requirements.
6. Books and Journals, as per Norms and Standards, have been procured, stamped and entered in the Accession Register.
7. Equipment, as per syllabus of first year, has been procured and is ready for use.
8. Copy of advertisement for recruitment of faculty, composition and proceedings of selection committee meeting.
9. Director / Principal has been appointed, and faculty identified and their consent letter for joining the institution obtained.
10. Adequate operational funds as per AICTE norms are available in the form FDR/ Savings Account/Current Account in the name of the Society/Trust for all the institutions run by the Trust.


The Expert Committee while examining the infrastructure / facilities will verify as to whether the development is in consonance with the proposal in the DPR and shall get a complete video CD of all the facilities.

The Expert Committee report shall be processed as per the revised Approval Process and the final decision for grant of approval or otherwise shall be communicated to all the concerned by AICTE on or before **May 16, 2005**.

The applicant Trust / Society is hereby informed that issuance of LOI by AICTE does not entitle it automatic grant of final Approval. The proposed institution cannot commence any educational activity and admit students based on LOI.

Please note that the Council would verify the  
The Approval accorded above is subject to fulfillment of the following  
conditions:

1. The institution must have affiliation to a University for the above courses  
before making admissions. In the absence of such Affiliation this letter of  
approval shall be treated as Withdrawn (Order of the High Court of Madras in  
W.P. No. 33256 of 2002 and other Batch of Petitions).

2. No admission shall be made by the Institution, contrary to the guidelines  
issued by AICTE for the academic session 2005-06. All the admissions must  
necessarily be made through Entrance Test.

3. The approved course(s) shall commence as per the academic calendar of the  
Affiliating University.

4. If this letter of approval is received by you after the closing date of State  
National Level Central Counseling for Admissions in the concerned State  
Union Territory, this letter of Approval will not be valid for making any  
admission during the above specified academic year, and shall be treated as  
withdrawn.

5. No excess admission shall be made by the institution during any academic  
year.

6. The approval is valid only for the academic year 2005-06. If no  
extension of AICTE approval is received beyond the academic year 2005-06,  
this Approval Letter will not be valid for making any admission for the  
subsequent years.

7. Any other condition(s) as may be specified by AICTE from time to time.

Consequent to the Supreme Court Judgment, the Model Constitution of  
Governing Body notified by AICTE in its approval Regulations 1994, stands  
overruled. It has been decided that while AICTE will not insist on any  
nomination in the Governing Body of Private Unaided Institution, the  
Affiliating University State Government shall impose minimum conditions of  
affiliation, such as, prescription of qualifications of Governing Body  
Members, in order to insure academic excellence. It shall be desirable for the  
private unaided institutions to induct at least 50% of the members of the  
Governing Body drawn from renowned academic, academic administrators,  
Subject Experts and professionals from industry in order to seek their  
innovative ideas for continuous improvement in the delivery of teaching  
learning process, matching best practices elsewhere and achieve excellence.

Please note that the Council would verify the status in respect of recruitment of faculty and rectification of other deficiencies through **Surprise Inspection** without any prior intimation. The institution shall be liable for strict action including action under the relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code in case false information is furnished to the Council.

The Council has decided to undertake inspections without any prior notice before extending approval for the year 2006-07 anytime after August 2005. A compliance report in respect of conditions/ deficiencies listed in Annexure - A must be sent to the Council before 31st August, 2005 in the absence whereof extension of approval for the year 2006-07 may not be considered.

The Compliance Report to be submitted to the Council by 31st August, 2005 should also be accompanied with a **Visiting/ Processing Fee** as prescribed by the Council in the form of Demand Draft in favour of the Member Secretary, AICTE payable at New Delhi. In the absence of the processing / visiting fee, the compliance report may not be entertained.

In the event of infringement/ contravention or non-compliance of the above Conditions and/or the provision of AICTE Act & Regulations/ Guidelines/ Norms & Standards as prescribed by AICTE, further actions leading to "Reduced Intake" or "No Admission" or "Withdrawal of Approval", shall be taken by AICTE and the liability arising out of such actions will be solely that of the Management/ Trust/ Society and/ or the Institution.

Annexure - 'A'

**Specific Condition :**

1. The institution must appoint faculty members as per the AICTE norms with pay scales as prescribed by AICTE, before making and admissions.
2. All the required Laboratories /Workshops / Machineries / Equipments, as per approved syllabi of the affiliating university, must be operational before making admissions.
3. The built up space should be provided for the institution as per AICTE norms.
4. The computer center should be equipped with computers and software's as per AICTE norms.
5. Books & journals should be provided as per AICTE norms in the library.
